Additional Points to Ponder

- Backstage Tours available for all group patrons for \$2 (\$5 otherwise).
- Groups of 15-26 paid guests are eligible for one additional free show ticket. Groups of 27-48 paid guests are eligible for three additional free show tickets and three free additional dinners (if the group is eating dinner). Groups of 49-103 paid guests are eligible for four additional free show tickets and four additional free dinners (if the group is eating). Tickets for groups of 104 paid guests will be negotiated per contract. Free tickets are included in the total number of tickets ordered.
- Your group is eligible to receive a free “TEXAS” souvenir program. Programs will be available upon arrival at the amphitheatre, and will be distributed to the group leader.
- State Park entry is waived after 5:00 p.m. for all “TEXAS” patrons
- Dinner is served from 6:00pm to 8:00pm in our designated eating area at the amphitheatre.
- Seating in the theatre begins at 7:45 p.m. and the show starts at 8:30 p.m.
- Handsets are available for those limited hearing guests
- Handicapped seating is available upon request
- Summer evenings can be delightfully cool, please come prepared.
- Rain Cancellation Policy: There are NO refunds for rain. “TEXAS” is performed in the rain and seldom cancelled. We will only offer rain checks if a performance is cancelled before intermission. If cancelled, patrons must collect a rain check voucher from the hospitality personnel or mail original ticket stub to be exchanged for vouchers within 15 days to 1514 5th Avenue, Canyon, TX 79015.

2. If reservation/purchase falls below 15 party members, regular published prices apply to the entire reservation.
3. A deposit of \$250.00 is due within 10 days following the signing of the contract. This payment is fully refundable up until 10 days prior to the performance, except for 4%, if reservations are made on a credit card.
4. Reservations are not confirmed until the deposit or full payment is received in the "TEXAS" office.
5. Reservations and an accurate guest count must be confirmed at least 10 days prior to performance date with the final full payment of balance, over the initial \$250.00.
6. If the reservation is made less than 10 days before the performance date, full payment and accurate guest count is due at the time of the reservation.
